In addition to the Swimming NZ Social Media Policy, the Waimea Swimming Club has got it's own to provide a safe and positive environment for all of its swimmers.

Acceptable Use Policy

- Cyber bullying and cyber stalking are unacceptable by any means or method, including but not limited to the use of facebook, text messaging, X, e-mail, Instagram or Snapchat. Please respect the rights and privacy of all other members
- Be respectful - ensure you post meaningful and at all times respectful comments, no spam and no remarks that can be deemed as offensive or hurtful. Your comments will be noticed and recorded forever in the social media environments. Remember you are responsible for your content and posts
- Do not use social media to post photos or make comments about another person without their knowledge or consent. Additionally, anonymous message boards and forums where posters use names that keep them anonymous are not acceptable
- Stick to your area of expertise and provide unique, individual perspectives on what's going on at the club
- Always pause and think carefully before posting
- If you are ever in doubt of the appropriateness of your online public material, consider whether it upholds and positively reflects your own values and ethics as well as that of the Waimea Swimming Club. Remember, always present a positive image, and don't do anything to embarrass yourself, the team, your family or the club or cause offense
